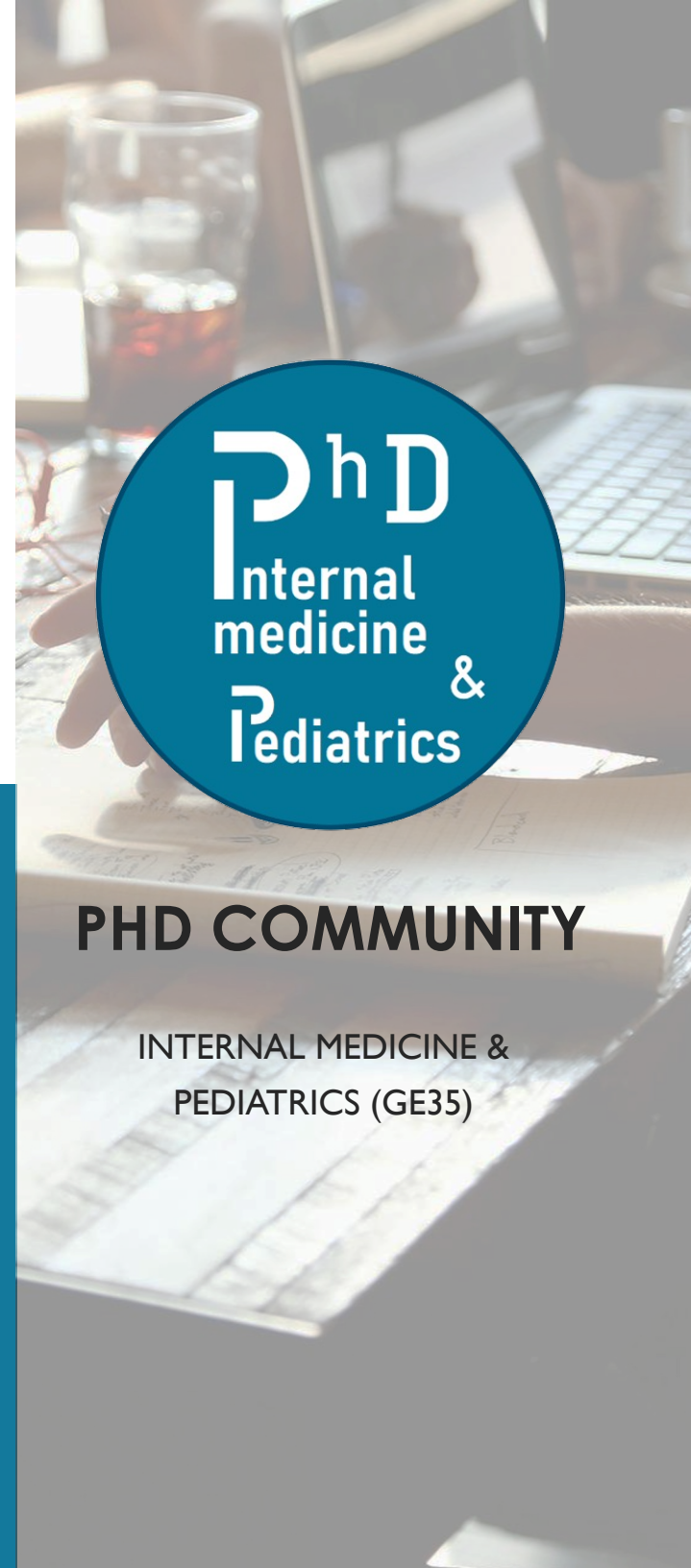

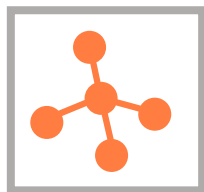

What do we have to offer?

Informal session 1x/month
