### **CONSUMABLES <20.000 euro**

#### **1. Research expenses:**

- Library materials (articles, books)
- Subscription fees (journals, platforms, survey monkey, databases, software,...)
- Interpreter/translator services
- Research material such as tablets, cameras, microphones, ...
- Lab supplies (chemicals, glassware, mice, zebrafish, housing animals,...)
- Transport costs of materials abroad or to the university
- Job students
- Time for the use of specific devices, infrastructure, libraries, ...
- Postal costs (to send questionnaires for the project)
- Rewards participants (focus groups, interviews, testing, ...)
- Promo material (flyers, posters,...)
- Costs at copy store (f.e. to print questionnaires)
- Costs for accessing (validated) questionnaires
- ...

#### **2. Small equipment:**

- Laptop
- Screen
- Printer
- Recording devices
- External storage
- Online storage/cloud
- ...

#### **3. Travel & Accommodation:**

- Conferences
- Workshops
- International project meetings
- Invitation of guest researchers
- Field work
- ...

#### **4. Dissemination:**

- Open access
- Proofreading services
- Copyrights
- Printing PhD (other costs of a PhD defense are not allowed)
- Organization symposium (related to the project)
- ...
