### 1. Who is my contact person concerning my application?

### 2. Who is my contact person at the master's programme?

### 3. Can I follow any master?

Yes you can, though considering following rules:  
Only for:

- Master's Programmes (master after bachelor)
- Subsequent Master's Programmes (master after master)

A list of courses taught in English can be found on the website (<http://www.opleidingen.ugent.be/studiegids/2007/EN/GENERAL/LIJSTE.HTM>). If applicants wants to follow their master in Dutch, a thorough knowledge of the Dutch language is required. Ghent University offers language courses, however these costs are not covered by the Master grant. ### 4. What degree do I have to have to be eligible?

Applicants should already have obtained a bachelor degree when they submit the application. No exceptions are allowed.

### 5. How detailed does my transcript of records has to be?

The transcript of records has to be as complete as can be. Note all the courses you've already followed including the obtained degrees. Please, do not submit any originals nor certified copies since no document will be returned.

We accept transcripts of records in English and French. The application form though, has to be completed in English.

### 6. For what period can i get a master grant?

The grants are awarded for the duration of the studies with a maximum of 2 years. In case of a 2-year-programme, the scholarship will only be paid for the full term if the student successfully completes the first year of the programme.

## **7. How do I apply?**

Online application, application via e-mail or fax will not be excepted. The application, drawn up on the required forms, should be delivered in 10 copies, stapled in the upper left hand corner.
